Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous AGM were approved unanimously.

Chair's Report: P Hughes, as acting Chair, delivered the Chair's Report (attached) in English, followed by M Williams who read it in Welsh.

Treasurer's Report: R Macaulay delivered the Treasurer's Report (attached). Currently running costs are in the region of £9000 per annum, so at the end of the current financial year there should be around two years money remaining.

Election of Trustees: All trustees resigned and stood for re-election. P Hughes, M Williams, R Macaulay, S Walczak, I de Wit, D Hazelgrove, Dot Hazelgrove and K Gwilliam were all re-elected unanimously.

Any other Business: A Perrott asked what was being done to increase use. P Hughes replied that children's and grown up's parties and funeral teas were being advertised. A Saturday morning Cafe should be opening, with pool tables etc for the younger people in the village. The Committee is open to suggestions for other entertainments and events.

A Drake-Lee suggested that table tennis should be available to children at a more favourable rate than charged to the Table Tennis Group.

A lively discussion followed regarding the age distribution of the trustees and previous problems with access for certain groups and the charity's procedures. P Hughes explained that the current Committee had only been in place for some three
